

## GARBAGE/BRUSH & TRASH DISPOSAL PROCEDURES

All trash will be picked up **twice a week** as per the Prospectus. Trash will be picked up on **Monday and Thursday between 8 am and 3:30 pm.** If a holiday falls on a scheduled pick-up day, trash will be picked up the following day. The doors of the dumpster/compactor area will be locked daily.

## <u>DO'S & DON'TS OF GARBAGE AND TRASH</u>

# GARBAGE/TRASH MUST BE OUT BY 8 A.M.

#### DO

- 1. Do **put your trash bags in trash cans** as required.
- 2. Do tie your trash bags in a knot.
- 3. Do place the trash can out by the curb not in the driveway.
- 4. Do break down all the cardboard boxes. Tie multiple boxes into bundles.
- 5. Do place yard waste in bags tied in a knot or sealed shut- limit 5 bags see Brush below.

#### DON'T

- 1. Do not overfill garbage bags as this makes them too heavy and they will tear. This also includes **leaves and dirt**.
- Do not use boxes or store bags as garbage bags.
- 3. Do not place trash bags out for pickup without placing them in a trash can.
- 4. Do not put newspapers in garbage bags. Take them to the clubhouse recycle bin.
- 5. Do not put garbage or trash outside of the compound at any time.

### **SPECIAL NOTES!**

WE CAN'T TAKE ANY ELECTRONIC DEVICES, PROPANE TANKS, TIRES, PAINT OR CHEMICALS. These must be taken to the Pinellas County Hazardous Collection Site. **Brush** must be no longer than 4 feet in length, tied in bundles that are not too heavy to be picked up and tossed into the truck.

No carpet/padding, furniture, or any construction debris will be picked up. Either the contractor or resident must dispose of these items.
